

### **High School Specific Issues**

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#### **Grading**

1. Each teacher must enter at least one assessment weekly in PowerSchool.
2. At the beginning of each quarter, each teacher must communicate to parents your process for grading. Your communication must include expectations for homework, testing, reassessment, and scoring procedures.

**Schedule-** 4x4 block with a daily seminar (home room time). With standards based grading, teacher review grade with students (9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>) on Mondays. Students are allowed to see other teachers during this time to reassess or review as needed.

**Eligibility-** Solon has a local rule prior to the end of a grading period

#### **Starts Week 4 of each quarter**

Weeks 1-3: Students are working on classroom assessments

Week 4: Sept. 10-14

- a. Notification of D or F given to student by seminar teacher (student conference)

Week 5: Sept. 17-21

- a. 2nd Notification for D or F in same course
- b. **Probation-** Send notice to parent via email or phone

Week 6: Sept. 24-28

- a. 3rd Notification for F in same course (D they are still eligible)
- b. **Ineligible-** Must sit out activities for one week

A student who starts on the D or F list after week 4 would follow the same process.

**Intervention time-** Solon has recently started a school wide guided study period for students that are failing classes starting Week 7 of each quarter.

Guided study is monitored and taught by content area teachers

**Monday-** History/Science/Arts

**Tuesday-** Math/Health/Business

**Wednesday-** L.Arts/For. Lang.

**Thursday-** CTE/Open for anyone

**Class Rank-** Solon does not do class rank for seniors

**Building Wide Reassessment Schedule-** See handout
